Contacting staff

It has been brought to our attention that we have a lot of parents contacting staff outside of work hours over personal social media to ask about their child or questions about the pre-school or seeing them in public.

It is against our policy for this to be happening and puts staff in awkward positions. Staff have been informed they are to not answer any messages regarding either subject and if they do see you in public that they are to not discuss your child or work.

If you would like to speak to a staff member this is to be done during pre-school hours in person or email the office.

Parents should <u>NOT</u> be contacting staff on any social media under any circumstances.

Toys

We have a lot of children currently bringing in toys from home lately. We cannot be responsible for any toys brought into playgroup if they go missing or get broken.

We would like to ask that you try to keep these at home or take with you once you have dropped your child to pre-school. It can be upsetting for your child if their toy goes missing or gets broken during the session and also frustrating for yourself.

Full day - Session times

Can we just remind parents about our full day session times.

We are either:

<u>8:30am to 2:30pm</u>

or

9am to 3pm

You cannot change these to suit your needs on the day.

If your session begins at 8:30am and you do not attend until 9am or later your session time will still finish at 2:30pm.

If your session time starts at 9am please do not bring your child in before this time.

Staff will soon be checking with parents and confirming which hours you will be attending.
